

in said Parish may be varied and increased or diminished and the apportionment thereof varied and amended for the seven years ensuing the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and ninety six in proportion to such average price when ascertained as aforesaid and to have said Composition and Rent Charge and the apportionment thereof varied and increased or diminished and amended accordingly.

And Whereas said William Lyngate Horner & Spratt and Margaret Carroll pursuant to said notice lodged their petition in writing dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October One thousand eight hundred and ninety six setting forth the premises with the Clerk of the Crown and Peace for Cork County East Riding and duly made application in writing for the purposes aforesaid to the Justices of the Peace for the County of Cork assembled at the said General Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for said County of Cork and in and for Cork County East Riding and Division of Cork at Cork the Twenty third day of October One thousand eight hundred and ninety six.

And Whereas said application duly came on for hearing before the Justices assembled at the said General Quarter Sessions of the Peace and was duly heard and considered by said Justices in presence of counsel for said Applicants and

counsel for Mr Atherton Pinham Esqrs claiming to be entitled to the said Composition and Rent Charge as the Lay Improprietor and after debate was by order of said Justices then and there made adjourned to the then ensuing General Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for said County Riding and Division that is to say the General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Cork in and for said County and Riding the Twelfth day of January One thousand eight hundred and ninety seven for further consideration.

And Whereas the said General Quarter Sessions of the Peace to which said application was made as aforesaid was duly continued for the purpose of said application thence henceforth.

And Whereas said application duly came on for hearing at said last mentioned General Quarter Sessions of the Peace before the Justices there assembled the said Twelfth day of January One thousand eight hundred and ninety seven in presence of said parties and their counsel pursuant to said order of adjournment and said Justices having duly considered said application and the evidence submitted to them on behalf of said Applicants and being satisfied that the said William Lyngate Horner & Spratt and Margaret Carroll were persons
