

Composition for all Tithes and the Rent Charge  
in lieu thereof now payable in said parts of  
said Parish of Calverduggan to the Atherton  
Tenham & Orrys as Lay Impropriator of said  
Parish be varied and diminished for the seven  
years ensuing the first day of November One  
thousand eight hundred and ninety six in such  
manner and to such extent that the amount  
of such Composition and Rent Charge for and  
during the said seven years ensuing said first  
day of November One thousand eight hundred  
and ninety six shall bear the like proportion  
to the amount of the Composition set forth  
in said Original Certificate of said John A.  
Braddell and John Mahony as payable to  
the Atherton Tenham & Orrys as said Lay  
Impropriator and to the Rent Charge  
herefore payable in lieu thereof as the average  
price of the barrel of oats for the seven  
years preceding said application that is to  
say Eleven shillings and one penny bears to the  
average price thereof set forth in said Original  
Certificate that is to say Fourteen shillings  
per barrel and accordingly that the amount  
of the said Composition be varied and diminished  
from the sum of Two hundred and eighty pounds  
to the sum of Two hundred and twenty one

pounds thirteen shillings and four pence by the  
year and that the amount of the Rent Charge  
now payable in lieu of said Composition be  
varied and diminished from the sum of Two  
hundred and ten pounds to the sum of One  
hundred and sixty six pounds five shillings by the  
year for the seven years ensuing the first day of  
November One thousand eight hundred and ninety  
six And we do further order and adjudge that  
the assessment and apportionment of said Composition  
and Rent Charge respectively be varied and diminished  
so as to bear the like proportion to the amount  
of said Composition and Rent Charge payable  
during the said seven years ensuing the first  
day of November One thousand eight hundred  
and ninety six as the original Assessment  
and apportionment of said Composition and Rent  
Charge did bear to said original Composition and  
Rent Charge and the costs of this application and  
of varying and reascertaining the amount of said  
Composition and Rent Charge and the apportionment  
thereof shall be defrayed by said Applicants.
