Resolved that this special Vestry do also on the behalf of the owners and occupiers of Land in said Parish consent and agree that such Composition shall be payable for the term of twenty one years from the first day of November 1824 (year) next ensuing the date of the Certificate aforesaid and that such Composition of nine hundred Pounds shall continue to be levied for such term of twenty one Years and shall not be subject to any variation in the amount thereof during such period of Twenty one Years under the provisions of the before recited Act or of an Act made in the fifth year of the Reign of King George the fourth entitled "an act to amend an Act of the last Session of Parliament &c for providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, &c &c" the price of Corn may be
