hereby Certify, that the true and just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within
the said Parish is three hundred and thirty
pounds ~~the~~ by the year, payable to the Reverend
Henry Sheehy's Successors, as Rector of said
Parish, pursuant to an agreement entered into
by the said Henry T. M. Dodder and a special
rector of said Parish: And we do further
Certify that, the average price of Oats, being the
Crown principally grown in said Counties, for the
period of seven years, ending the first day of
November One thousand, eight hundred, and
twenty one, is fifteen Shillings, and two pence
farthing, late Irish Currency, per Bushel.
