Edward Sympson of Shelburne Clerk of the Peace in the County  
of Galway Clerk of the Peace of said Parish, the sum of forty  
Pounds Sterling being the three parts of eight parts  
of said sum of one hundred and seventy Pounds Sterling  
is due and payable to the Chapter of Inam and  
the Very Reverend Thomas Pater Clerk of the Peace and Chapter  
warden by virtue of their rights as Dean and Chapter  
of Inam the sum of thirty Pounds Sterling being three  
parts of eight parts of said sum of one hundred and  
seventy Pounds Sterling
