The Rectorial Tithes amount to Thirty six pounds,  
Eighteen Shillings and five pence halfpenny British  
Money which is equal to Forty Pounds Irish Money,

The Vicarial Tithes amount to one Hundred  
and forty seven Pounds Thirteen Shillings and ten pence  
halfpenny British money, which is equal to one  
Hundred and Sixty Pounds Irish Money,

The Improprate Tithe is due and payable to  
Bindon Scott Esq<sup>r</sup> out of the following Lands <sup>At</sup>  
Drumquin, Cragherewin, Cragbrien, Lishsheen,  
Clonmore, Caherea East, Lanna, Caherea West,  
Clondrina, Cloncoleman, Braffa, Diacamede,

Lissicasey, Gurtigihene, Furrure and Ballycorick,

The Improprate Tithes amount to Two Hundred  
and Thirty Pounds fifteen Shillings and five pence  
British money, which is equal to Two Hundred and  
Fifty Pounds Irish Money,

of November 1825 and it is to continue for the Term  
of Twenty one years without any variation whatsoever,
