do hereby certify, that the true and just Amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish
is Four hundred and Fifty Pounds by the year, of which
sum, of Four hundred and Fifty Pounds Forty Pounds are
due and payable to the Reverend Richard Kennedy
out of the Towns and Lands of Ballyclohisey, Argepark
and Pigsfield, Knockalish, Savalla South (including
Ballycunnigham) Cappanagara, Savalla North, and
Knockbay and Irishalane being part of the Townlands
of Ballycaick, as a Composition for the Tithes claimable
by him as Rector of said Lands being part of the said
Parish, One hundred and Sixty Pounds are due and
payable to the said Richard Kennedy out of the Towns
and Lands of Drumquinn, Cragherwin, Cragbrien,
Lishkane, Clonmore, Caherea East, Lanna, Caherea
West, Clondrina, Cloncolman, Breaffa, Diacamede,
Lispicary, Gurtigehene, Furrine, Cowne Island, and
part of Ballycaick, as a Composition for the Tithes claim-
able by him as Vicar of said Lands, being part of the
said Parish, and Two hundred and Fifty Pounds are
due and payable to Bindon Scott Esquire out of the
Towns and Lands of Drumquinn, Cragherwin, Crag-
brien, Lishkane, Clonmore, Caherea East, Lanna,
Caherea West, Clondrina, Cloncolman, Breaffa,
Diacamede, Lispicary, Gurtigehene, Furrine, and
part of Ballycaick, as a Composition for the Tithes
claimable by him as Lay Impropriator of said
Lands being part of the said Parish, and we do
