If you want to verify the results, you
must work them out. I really cannot
copy them out a fresh. But I think
that you may trust them as correct.

The whole process comes out as follows
394 : 349 :: 380 : $\frac{378.17.4}{159.5.9}$ - so that
the fraction, which is very accurate, only
to 5th on the whole, or 2nd for each of us.

I should be very glad to have the account
as soon as possible, that I may add it to
the Commission, one way or another.
