

November one Thousand Eight Hundred and twenty one was one pound Eighteen  
 Shillings and eight pence half penny  $\times \times \times$  of the late Irish Currency which is equal  
 to the sum of one pound fifteen Shillings and eight pence three farthings Sterling  
 British and that in consequence thereof they the said Commissioners had fixed the  
 amount of the Composition for tithes in said Parish of Dunganee at Four  
 hundred and eighty pounds Sterling annually that is to say Three hundred and  
 twenty pounds as the Vicarial Tithes and One hundred and sixty pounds as the  
 Vicarial Tithes and payable to the Incumbent and Lay Impropriator of the  
 said Parish respectively. NOW it appearing to us the said Justices assembled  
 at the Quarter Sessions of the peace for the County of Kilkenny held at Grace Old  
 Castle in the County of Kilkenny on the Twenty fourth day of June One Thousand Eight  
 Hundred and thirty six that the said Mathew Keefe John Doyle John Maher Charles  
 Ryan and William Maher have supported by evidence their Applications and we  
 having enquired into the same and it appearing to us that the said Commissioners  
 appointed under the fourth and fifth George the fourth to Value the Tithes in the  
 said Parish of Dunganee in the Diocese of Ossory and County of Kilkenny had fixed  
 the said Composition for the said Parish at Four hundred and eighty pounds  
 Sterling yearly to commence from the first day of November One Thousand Eight hundred  
 and twenty one and that what was the measure of Composition for Tithes of said  
 Parish of Dunganee and that it was one pound Eighteen Shillings and eight  
 pence half penny <sup>Sterling of the</sup> late Irish Currency per Bannell being equivalent to a Sum  
 of one pound fifteen Shillings and eight pence three farthings  $\times \times \times$  British  
 Currency for the seven years preceding the year One Thousand Eight Hundred  
 and twenty one. And it appearing to us that the average price of Good  
 marketable wheat for the last seven years was one pound eight Shillings and  
 five pence half penny per Bannell we do therefore order adjudge and Decree  
 that the said Tithes Composition be diminished by a sum of forty seven  
 pounds nine Shillings and two pence annually and that the same shall now  
 be three hundred and eighty two pounds ten Shillings and two pence Sterling  
 annually instead of the sum of Four hundred and eighty pounds Sterling  
 annually in the proportions following that is to say Two hundred and fifty five  
 pounds and seven pence Sterling as and for the Vicarial Tithes instead of Three  
 hundred and twenty pounds <sup>Sterling</sup> annually and One hundred and twenty seven pounds  
 ten Shillings and three pence as and for the Vicarial Tithes instead of One  
 hundred and sixty pounds Sterling annually and that the same shall Commence  
 and be payable in the proportions above mentioned from the first day of  
 November next ensuing the date of this our Order or adjudication. Given
