of said Parish by Alexander O'Beirne Esq. as Lessee of the Improvements
of Part of said Parish and by Nathaniel Swanson Esq. as Lessee

of another Part of said Parish do hereby certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all tithes claimable within the said Parish by the
Reverend Edward Jones M.A. Vicar of the said Parish and by the
said Alexander O'Beirne Esq. as Lessee of the Improvements of part of
said Parish and by Nathaniel Swanson Esq. as Lessee of the Improvements
of another part of said Parish is seven hundred and twenty
pounds Sterling by the year being the sum agreed upon
between the Parishioners and the said Reverend Edward Jones
