Parish - Do hereby Certify that the true and just Amount of Compensation
for all tithes claimable within the said Parish by the Reverend Edward Jones
Rector as Vicar of the said Parish, and by Alexander B. Biscoll Esq. as Lessee
of the Improper tithes of Part of said Parish and by Nathaniel Coanor
Esq. as Lessee of the Improper tithes of an other Part of said Parish is
Seven hundred and twenty Pounds ster. by the year being the sum agreed upon
between the Parson and the said Reverend Edward Jones Rector Alexander
B. Biscoll Esq. and Nathaniel Coanor Esq. at Justice's Liberty summoned
and held in Pursuance of the Acts of Parliament in such case made
and Provided of which the sum of Three hundred and twenty Pounds ster.
