by Virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth
intituled an act to provide for the Establishment of Compositions of Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all
Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the parish of Gliskane in the
County of Wicklow and part in the Queens County and Diocese of Ossory

Do Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatsoever within the said parish is one Hundred pounds by the year for the
term of Twenty one years from the first day of May next Subject to Variation
every seven years according to the Act which sum of one Hundred pounds by
the year is due and payable to the Rev^d Marcus Monk as Rector and Vicar of the
said parish as a Composition for the Tithes Claimable by him as Rector and
Vicar of said parish

And we do further Certify that the Average price of Wheat being the Corn
principally grown in such Counties for the period of seven years ending on
the first day of November Eighteen hundred and Twenty one according to the
Schedule thereof furnished by the Right Hon^{ble} Henry Goulbourn Chief Secretary
to the Lord Lieutenant of Ireland is one pound Eighteen Shillings and eight
pence halfpenny per Barrel
