

At a Vestry held in the Parish Church of Arklow, (For the Parish of Kildrude) in the Union of Arklow Dioc. of Dublin and County of Wicklow, on Monday the 10th day of January 1825, under the Composition Act, of which due notice was given according to Act of Parliament.

We the Undersigned Appointed as Special Vestry men, do assent to the Payment of Two Hundred and Seventeen Pounds of which Two Hundred Pounds is due and Payable to the Rev^d Henry Lambert Vicar of said Parish, and his Successors and Seventeen Pounds to Mr. Charles Cooper as Lessee of the Improvements of the half Corn tithes of Ladbank, Killynisking, Ballymoney, Johnstown, Ballyquihard, Tovybank, Killyigh, Terinick, and part of Ballinacloy, and Templemore, in said Parish.

And we do also assent on behalf of the Owners and Occupiers of Land in said Parish that the Composition above named be successive for the term of Twenty one Years from the first day of May One Thousand eight Hundred and Twenty five,
