hundred & twenty seven Pounds twelve Shillings & two Pence
by the year, which sum of One hundred & twenty seven Pounds
twelve Shillings & two Pence is due & payable to Charles
Barry Esquire as a Composition for the Tithes claim-
able by him as Lay Impropriator of said Parish,

Which I do further Certify that the Average Price
of Cots being the Corn principally grown in such
County for the Period of seven years ending the
First day of November 1830 is Thirteen Shillings
& three pence three fourths of a pence
