do hereby Certify that the true & just Amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the
said Parish is One hundred & twenty seven Pounds twelve Shillings
& two Pence by the year, which sum of One hundred & twenty
seven Pounds twelve Shillings & two Pence is due & payable to
Charles Barry Esquire as a Composition for the Tithes
claimable by him as Lay Impropriator of said Parish

And I do further Certify that the Average Price of oats
being the Corn principally grown in such County
for the Period of seven years ending on the first
day of November 1830 is Thirteen Shillings & three pence
three farthings & a mace
