

We the Undersigned of Gort and Killy Cannore of Mullmonee  
County of Galway Esqrs. Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and  
virtue of an Act made in fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, (intituled  
"An Act to provide for the establishment of Composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited  
time" and by the amended Act 5<sup>th</sup> Geo. 4<sup>th</sup> Chap. 65) to ascertain and fix a true and  
just composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the  
Parish of Killebrist in the County of Galway, do hereby Certify that the true  
and just amount of Composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or  
payable within the Parish of Killebrist is Eighty Eight Pounds Ster. (British  
Currency) by the year: of which sum of Eighty Eight Pounds Ster. Sixty Six  
Pounds Ster. are due and payable to the Rev. Paw MacTighe and his Successors  
as a Composition for all tithes claimable by him as Rector of said  
Parish. Three Pounds Ster. are due and payable to the Rector of the Vicar  
Choral of Christ Church Dublin, as composition for a portion of the tithes  
of the Townland of Gortnamonagh in said Parish — and Nineteen  
Pounds <sup>ster.</sup> are due and payable to the Bishop of the Diocese of Ulster.

And We do further Certify that this Composition is to continue in force for  
Twenty one years from the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 1826 (viz) without alteration  
according to the Provisions of the said Act of Parliament.
