of Galway, do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes
arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Miltinst is Eighty Eight
Pounds the British Currency by the year: of which sum of Eighty Eight Pounds the
Sixty Six ^{Pounds the} are due and payable to the Rev Edward Keatinge and his Successors as a
composition for all tithes claimable by him &c: as Rector of the said Parish —
Three Pounds the: are due and payable to the Lessee of the Vicarage of Christ Church
Dublin as a Composition for a portion of the tithes of the townland of Gortnamona
in the said Parish — and fifteen Pounds the: are due and payable to the Bishop
of the Diocese of Tuam — And We do further Certify that this
Composition is to continue in force for Twenty one years, from the first day of Novem-
ber 1826 (Six) without alteration, according to the provisions of the said Acts
of Parliament — (Dated and Signed under Our hands and Seals the xxix
27th day of October 1826 (Six) —
