

We the Undersigned John Delmege of Gort and Henry Cannon of Millmount, County of Galway Esqrs. Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth (intituled "An Act to provide for the establishment of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time and by the amended Act 5th George the 4th Chap: 63) to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Tiltmunt in the County of Galway. Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Tiltmunt is Eighty Eight Pounds Ster. British Currency by the year: of which Sum of Eighty Eight Pounds Ster. Sixty Six Pounds are and are payable to the Rev. Edward Hartigan and his Successors as a composition for all tithes claimable by him or as Rector of the said Parish — Three Pounds Ster. are and are payable to the Rector of the Church of Christ Church Dublin as a composition for a portion of the tithes of the town and of Gortnamonagh in the said Parish — and nineteen pounds Ster. are and are payable to the Bishop of the Diocese of Kilmacduagh — And We do further Certify that this Composition is to continue in force for Twenty one years, from the first day of November 1826 (Six) without alteration according to the provision of the said Act of Parliament — Dated and Given under our hands and seals this 27th day of October 1826 (Six) —
