the true and just Amount of Composition for
all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is
Two hundred and seventy pounds Sterling by
the year of which sum of Two hundred and
seventy pounds two thirds are due and payable
to the Rev. Thomas Trench Dean or to his Tithe
Farmer Benjamin Digby Odlum Esq^r as a
Composition for all Tithe claimed by them as
Rector and Farmer of the said Parish and
One third of the above Two hundred and Seventy
pounds is due and payable to the Rev. John
Jones as owner of the Vicarial Tithes of
said Parish
