

I, Samuel Gordon, Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of the Reign of King William the Fourth intituled "an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent": to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Kileoane in the County of Kilkenny and Diocese of Ossory, do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is one hundred and thirteen pounds one shilling and eleven pence half penny sterling by the year, which said sum is due and payable to the Reverend Henry Bunbury as a composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish. And I do further certify
