under and by virtue of an Act passed in the

Entitled, An Act to amend Three Acts passed respectively
in the 4th, 5th and in the 7th & 8th years of the Reign of His Late
Majesty King George 4th providing for the establishing of
Composition for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compo-
-sition permanent, to ascertain and fix a true and just
Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or pay-
-able within the Parish of Kiltowanmore in the County
of Wexford, do hereby certify that the true and just
amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within
the said Parish is Twenty Pounds Stg. by the year, which
sum of Twenty Pounds Stg. is due and payable to Francis
Lynch Esq. as Lay Impropriator, and sole Proprietor of the
Tithes of said Parish of Kiltowanmore

And I do further certify that the average price of oats
being the corn principally grown in this County for the
period of seven years ending on the 1st of Nov. 1830
is Twelve shillings and Eleven Pence per Acre
