for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just  
composition for all tithes arising growing <sup>or</sup> payable  
within the Parish of Kildemock in the County of Louth  
Do hereby Certify that the true and just Amount  
of Composition for all tithes whatsover within said Parish  
is the sum of Two hundred pounds British Currency  
by the Year which sum is due and payable to the  
Reverend Arthur Ellis as a Composition for the tithes  
claimable by him as Rector of said Parish And we  
do further Certify that the average price of Oats being  
the Corn principally grown in such County, for the  
Period of Seven Years ending on the first day of  
November One thousand eight hundred and twenty one  
is fifteen Shillings and two pence farthing Rate Currency  
Dated this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1829
