true & just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said
Parish is $\text{£}6$ ten shillings & four pence sterling by the year due & payable
to the Rev. Tho. McCulloch the Vicar of the said Parish

And we do further certify that the Average price of wheat, being the
Grain principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on
the first day of November 1821 is $\text{£}18$ 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ per Barrel of Twenty
Stone
