 of composition for all the Vicarial tithes within said parish is Eighty
 Pounds by the year which sum is due and payable to Henry Bentley Esq:
 of Glanlin in said County as a Composition for the tithe claimable by
 him on the part of the Rev^d Standish Quady Rector of said parish. -
 And we do further Certify that the true and just amount of Composition
 for all the Vicarial tithes within said parish is Fifty six Pounds ten
 shillings and four pence by the year which sum is due and payable to
 the Rev^d Thomas M^c Cullagh Vicar of said parish as a Composition
 of the tithe claimable by him of said parish October 25th 1825 (five)
