said Parish is seven hundred and fifty nine pounds nine shil-
lings and two pence Sterling by the Year, of which sum of seven
hundred and fifty nine pounds nine shillings and two pence
one half is due and payable to the Reverend Thomas Lloyd as
a Composition for the Tithe claimed by him as Vicar of said
Parish, and the other one half is due and owing to Richard Arm-
strong Senior Charles Armstrong and Richard Armstrong Junior as
Lay Impropriators And I do further Certify that the Average
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in said Parish
for the Period of seven Years ending the first day of November one
thousand eight hundred and thirty is twelve shillings and Ele-
ven pence halfpenny ^{British} per Barrel
