of King George the Fourth, to ascertain and fix
a due & just amount of composition, for all
the tithes & other duties payable, within

the Parish of Hilgoburn, in the United Diocese of
Lincoln, & West & Atherstone, in the County of
Warwick - Do hereby certify, that the due & just
amount of composition for all tithes, whatever
within said Parish, is Four Hundred & Twenty
Two Pounds £ . by the year, which sum of Four
Hundred & Twenty Two Pounds £ . is to be & payable

to the Rev. Edward Day as Rector of said Parish.

And we do further certify that the average
price of oats being the corn principally sown
for the period of seven years ending the first day
of Nov. 1821, was fifteen Shillings and Two pence
farthing p . per Bushel of four quarters Stone
