and sworn under and by virtue of an act made
in the 2nd & 3rd years of the reign of King William the
4th Entitled an act to amend three acts passed respectively
the 4th 5th & 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty
King George the 4th providing for the establishing of
Composition for tithes in Ireland and to make such
Composition permanent to ascertain & fix a true and
just Composition for all tithes arising growing
yielding and payable within the Parish of Kilkenny
in the County of Kilkenny. do hereby certify that the
true and just amount of Composition for all tithes
whenever within the said Parish is £105. by the year
which sum is due and payable to the Vicars of
St Canice, Kilkenny as Vicars of said Parish
as a Composition for tithes claimed by them. do
hereby further certify that the average price of wheat
being the Corn principally grown in such County for
the period of seven years ending on the 1st Nov^r
1830 is one pound twelve and one half pence
per barrel dated this 29th October 1833
