

I William Young being duly appointed and sworn Commissioner under and by virtue of an Act made in the 2^d and 3^d years of the Reign of King William the 4th Chap 119 entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4. 5. 7 and 8 years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the 4th Providing for the establishment of compositions permanent (16 August 1833) to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielding or payable within the Parish of Hillierigg otherwise Haglin in the County of Carlisle, do certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever in said Parish is Sixty nine Pounds two Shillings and Ten Pence Sterling by the Year, and that the said Sum of Sixty nine Pounds two Shillings and Ten Pence is payable in the following Proportions and to the following persons viz^t - To Alexander Humphrey as Executor of Lucinda Caulfield Osborn three fifths To John Gale Treu one fifth and to Mrs Sarah Milton one fifth as a Composition for all Tithes claimed by them as Lay Impropriators of said Parish, and I do further Certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County for the Period of seven years ending the first day of November 1830 is One Pound Twelve Shillings per Barrel -
