2^d and 3^d year of the Reign of King William the 4th Chap
119 entitled An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the
4th 5th 7th and 8th years of the Reign of his late Majesty King
George the 3^d Providing for the establishment of Compositions
permanent (16th August 1833) to ascertain and fix a true
and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielding
or payable within the Parish of Keeney otherwise Urquain
in the County of Carlow, do certify that the true and just
Amount of Composition for all tithes whatever in said Parish
is Sixty nine pounds two shillings and two pence sterling by
the year and that the said sum of Sixty nine pounds
two shillings and two pence is payable in the following proportions
and to the following persons viz^t. To Alexander Humphrey as
Executor of Lucinda Caulfield Orton three fifths To
John Gale Two one fifth and to Mrs Sarah Elliot one
fifth as a Composition for all Tithes claimed by them as
Sole Proprietors of said Parish and I do further Certify
that the average price of wheat being the Corn principally
grown in said County for the period of seven years ending
the first day of November 1830 is one pound twelve shillings
p. Barrel
