in the County of Sligo, send greeting, WHEREAS pursuant to the Provisions of an Act passed in the second and third years of his present Majesty King William the 4th, intituled "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," *John Brumby of Castlebrangan in the County of*

*Sligo Esquire* has truly served me with a Notice in Writing, in the words and figures following:—

SIR,

You are hereby required to take Notice, that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 2nd and 3rd Years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled, "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th, and in the 7th and 8th years of the Reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," I *John Brumby of Castlebrangan in the County of*

*Sligo* who am seized in *Freehold* of all that and those the Townland of *Cartonhugh* containing *One Hundred and Seventy* Acres English Statute Measure or thereabouts, the Meas and Bounds whereof are as follow (that is to say) as to the Townland of *Cartonhugh* bounded on the North and East by *Curragh* on the South by *Drumcra & Carronstaylor* and on the West by *Carronstaylor*.

do hereby signify to you

*my* desire to agree for and undertake the payment of the Composition for Tythes lawfully payable for and in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby require you to grant to

*me* a Certificate in writing conformable to the Provisions of the said Act, declaring *me* entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other matters on your part required by the said Act to be done.
