

We Abraham Sandys of Kiltormer and Michael Monahan of Portumna Esqrs Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth, entitled and act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tythes arising growing yielding, or payable within the Parish of Kiltormer in the County of Galway, do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tythes whatever within the said Parish is two hundred and Ten pound by the year, of which Sum of Two hundred and Ten pounds Ster^l one hundred and Twenty pounds Ster^l is due and payable to the Rev^d Richard Gye as vicar and rector of the said parish, and ninety pounds Ster^l is due and payable to the Bishop of the diocese of Clonfert, and we do further Certify that the average price of oats, being the the corn principally grown in such County, for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 twenty one is Ten shillings and six pence by the barrel, when under our hands and seals this fourteenth day of January eighteen hundred and twenty four.
