

We Dennis Kelly and Sam Kelly Com
duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of a
statute in the fourth year of the reign of King George the 4th,
intituled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions
for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain and fix
a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing
yielded, or payable within the Parish of Tullerow in the
County of Roscommon, do hereby certify that the true and
just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within
the said Parish is one hundred and thirty pounds Sterling
Brit. Currency by the year of which sum of one hundred and
thirty pounds, one half is due and payable to the Rev. Aaron
Callahan as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him
as Vicar of the said Parish, namely the sum of sixty-seven
pounds, and the sum of sixty-five pounds being also one
half to the incorporated Society as a Composition for Tithes
claimable by them
And we do further certify that the average price of Cattle
being the corn principally grown in such County for the
period of seven years ending on the first of Nov 1821 is
ten shillings and six pence late currency of Great Britain
