

I certify that I have received the following notice from Lord Crofton  
Sir. You are hereby required to take notice that in pursuance of an  
Act passed in the 2nd. and 3rd. years of the Reign of his Majesty King  
William the Fourth, entitled an Act to amend three Acts, passed re-  
spectively in the 4th. 5th. and in the 7th. 8th. years of the Reign of  
his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establish-  
ing of Compositions permanent. I Lord Crofton of Muck Park  
Chief Landlord seized in fee simple of that and those the lands  
of Cammadda, Moneymore, Race course, Tokerfen, Corry,  
Knockragive, Curgeriff, Ballymurry, Greenhall, Baggin,  
Moate Demesne, and Ballyroos the meres and bounds  
whereof are as follows - that is to say bounded on the North  
by Newtown and Lisides, on the South by Kilcash & Brounyap,  
on the East by Curry, and on the West by Trimaria, situate in  
the Parish of Kilmacree, Barony of Athlone, and County of Car-  
low, or being otherwise entitled according to the pro-  
visions of the said Act to agree for and undertake the  
payment of the Composition for Tithes lawfully payable for  
and in respect of said lands, do hereby signify to you my desire  
to agree for and undertake the payment of such Compositions,  
as aforesaid for and in respect of said lands, and I do hereby re-  
quire you to grant to me a Certificate in writing, conforma-  
ble to the provisions of the said Act declaring me entitled to  
the benefit of this notice, and to perform the other matters  
on your part required by said Act to be done. Dated this 12th  
To the Rev. Peter Browne, Incumbent day of February 1833, Parson  
of the Parish of Kilmacree in the Co. Carlow. (Signed) "Crofton"
