x duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an
Act made in the Fourth year of the Reign of King George
the Fourth entitled "An Act to provide for the establishing
of compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time."

To ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all
tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish
of Killeilagh in the County of Westmeath. do hereby
certify that the true & just amount of composition for
all tithes whatever within the said Parish is one hundred
and fifty two pounds six shillings and one penny three
farthings British Currency of which sum of one hundred
and fifty two pounds six shillings and one penny three
farthings thirty six pounds eighteen shillings & five
pence halfpenny is due & payable to the Reverend
Michael Devereux. Doctor in Divinity as a composition
for the tithes claimable by him as vicar of the said
Parish; and that the remainder of said sum of one
hundred and fifty two pounds six shillings and one penny
three farthings British Currency, being one hundred
and fifteen pounds seven shillings and eight pence one
farthing, is due and payable to Nicholas Ogle Esq, as a
composition for the tithes claimable by him as impropriator of the
