fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth Intituled "an Act to  
provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland for a  
limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all  
vicarial Tythes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish  
of Killummod in the Diocese of Elphin and County of Roscommon  
Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all  
vicarial Tythes within the said Parish is Forty-two pounds British Sterling  
by the year, which sum is due and payable to the Reverend William Smith  
as a Composition for the Tythes claimable by him as Vicar of the said Parish,  
and to be continued invariable for twenty one years from the first day  
of May 1827 seven. And we do further Certify that the average price of  
Oats being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of  
seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 one is fifteen  
shillings and two pence ster<sup>g</sup> p<sup>r</sup> Barrel
