for the tyth claimable by him as Rector  
of Donagherry. And we do further certify that  
the average price of oats being the corn principally  
grown in such County for seven years ending  
the first day of November 1821 was fourteen  
shillings and one farthing (British) per barrel  
as taken from the Dublin Gazette
