do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Com-  
position for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish  
is thirty six pounds. But in Currency by the year of which  
sum of thirty six pounds one half is due and payable  
to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Vicar Gallaher as a Composition for all Tithes  
claimable by him as Vicar of the said Parish. Namely  
the sum of eighteen pounds and the sum of eighteen  
pounds being also one half to the Lay Impresariators  
the Mess<sup>rs</sup> Armstrongs as a Composition for Tithes  
claimable by them.
