

I certify that I have received the following notice from Lord Crofton

Sir,  
You are hereby required to take notice that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 2<sup>d</sup> and 3<sup>d</sup> years of the reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth entitled an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> and the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the reestablishing of compositions permanent. I Lord Crofton of Moate Park Chief Landlord seized in fee simple of all that and those the lands of Carnamadda, Moneymore, Racecourse, Sokerfin, Conry, Shankenshine, Cargarriff, Ballymurry, Green Hall, Boggin, Moate Demenee and Bollinree, the metes and bounds whereof are as follows - that is to say bounded on the north by heathen and lishide, on the south by Silcask and Crowsgap, on the east by Conry and on the west by Trimane, situate in the Parish of Silmain Barony of Uthman and County of Down, or being otherwise entitled according to the provisions of the said Act to agree for and undertake the payment of the composition for tithes lawfully payable for and in respect of said lands, do hereby signify to you my desire to agree for and undertake the payment of such composition as aforesaid for and in respect of said lands, and I hereby require you to grant to me a certificate in writing conformable to the provisions of the said Act declaring me entitled to the benefit of this notice, and to perform the other matters on your part required by said act to be done dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February 1833 three
