Lessee of the Impropritate tithes of said ~~Part~~ Parish: Do hereby  
Certify That the true and just Amount of Compositions for all  
Tithes claimable within the said Parish by the said Nathaniel  
Swanson Esq. as Lessee of the said Impropritate tithes is Eighty  
Six Pounds fifteen Shillings Set. By the year being the sum  
Agreed upon between the Parsonage and the said Nathaniel
