

I, *Wm. Vistitt* (having been duly appointed and sworn a Commissioner under, and by virtue of, an Act made in the Second and Third years of the Reign of King WILLIAM IV. intituled--"An Act to amend Three Acts passed in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth years of his late Majesty King GEO. IV., providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent"--to Ascertain and Fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable within the Parish of *Rihmanagh* in the County of *Wexford*) do hereby Certify, that the True and Just Composition for all Tithes, whatever, within the said Parish is *Eighty one pounds eight shillings and two pence half*

by the Year, of which Sum of *Eighty one pounds eight shillings and two pence half* is due and payable to *Mr. Revd Mr. Smyth* as a Composition claimable by him as  *Vicar* of said Parish,

*The other half* is due and payable to *Lord Visct. Lorton Mr. Young and Mr. Butler* as *Lay Impropriators* of said Parish, *Wm. Vistitt*  
*Lord Visct. Lorton Twenty six pounds 16 shillings*  
*Mr. Young Ten pounds six shillings and 6 pence*  
*Mr. Butler Three pounds 11 shillings and 9 pence*  
*Total half Forty pounds fourteen shillings and 7 pence*

And I do further Certify, that the average price of Oats—being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven Years, ending the First Day of November, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty—is *Twelve shillings per Acre* per Barrel.
