two Shillings and seven pence Halfpenny by the Year which Sum is due and
payable to the Reverend Thomas Kemmis as a Composition of the Tithes Claimable
by him as Rector and Vicar of Said Parish and we do further certify that the
foregoing Written pages of this Book contain our applotment for Levying One Hundred
and forty One pounds two Shillings & seven pence Halfpenny by the Year and payable
Half Yearly for the full End and term of twenty One Years without any Variation of prices
of Grain whatsoever Dated this 25th day of February 1825
