duly appointed, and sworn, under and by virtue of
an act made in the fourth year of the reign of
King George the fourth Entitled "an act to provide
for the establishing of compositions for tithes in
Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and
fix, a true and just composition for all
tithes arising, growing yielded or payable
within the Parish of Milseely in the County of
Clare, do hereby certify, that the true and just
amount of composition for all tithes whatever, within
the said Parish is two hundred and forty pounds
(British) by the year, ~~of which~~
and twenty pounds are due and payable to the Rev^d
Francis Synge, as a composition for all tithes claimable
by him, as rector of said Parish, and one hundred
and twenty pounds (British) are due and payable
to the Rev^d W^m Butler, as a composition for tithes
claimable by him as Vicar of said Parish. The
first half yearly payment, to become due and
payable on the first day of May eighteen
hundred and twenty seven.
