

We Richard Tonton and Charles I case Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the 4th and 5th years of the reign of King George the Fourth entitled "An Act to provide for the Establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielding or payable within the Parish of Kiltigan in the Counties of Wicklow and Carlow Do hereby Certify that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is 516 pounds by the Year of which sum 310 pounds are payable to William Wensworth Fitz-William Home Esquire as a Composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Lay impropriator and 176 pounds are payable to the Reverend William Scott the Vicar of said Parish according to an Agreement entered into at a Vestry held in the Parish Church of Kiltigan on the 16th day of October 1826 which Agreement is to continue for the full Term of 21 Years without Variation And we do ^{partly} Certify that the Average Price of Oats being the corn principally grown in said Parish of Kiltigan in said Counties of Wicklow and Carlow for the period of 7 Years ending on the 1st day of November 1821 is fifteen Shillings two pence and one seventh of a penny late Irish Currency being fourteen Shillings and one seventh of a penny British Currency
