and just composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or payable
within the Parish of Kilmalebeg, in the Diocese of Limerick and County
of Waterford; Do hereby certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is Eight
Hundred and Ten pounds Two Shilling and Three halfpence by the year
of which the sum of Two Hundred and seventy four shillings and four pence
half penny being the one third part of said sum of Eight hundred and
Ten pounds Two Shilling and Three halfpence, is due and payable to
Reverend Henry Scott Smith as a composition for one third of the
tithes of said Parish claimable by him as the Vicar thereof, and the
sum of Five hundred and Forty pounds and nine pence being the two
parts of said sum of Eight hundred and Ten pounds Two Shilling and
Three halfpence, is due and payable, To His Grace The Most Noble
William Shrewsbury Duke of Devonshire, as a composition for the remaining
Two thirds of the tithes of said Parish claimable by him as Lay impropriator
thereof, and I further certify that the average price of Oats being the
corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven years
ending on the first of November One thousand Eight hundred and
Thirty is Twelve Shillings and Eleven pence half penny per Barrel,
