of which the sum of Two hundred and seventy pounds and four pence
halfpenny being the one third part of said sum of Eight hundred and
Ten pounds one Shilling and three half pence is Due and payable to
The Reverend Bery Scott Smith as a composition for one third of the
tithes of said Parish claimable by him as the vicar thereof, and the
sum of Five hundred and Forty pounds and nine pence being ^{the} ~~the~~ ^{two}
parts of said sum of Eight hundred and Ten pounds one Shilling
and three half pence, is due and payable to His Grace The Most Honble
William Spencer Duke of Devonshire, as a composition for the remaining
two thirds of the tithes of said Parish claimable by him as Lay
appropriator thereof and I further certify that the average price of
Oats being the corn principally grown in such County for the period
of seven years ending on the first of November One thousand
eight hundred and thirty is Twelve Shillings and eleven pence, half
