the 4<sup>th</sup> providing for the establishing of Compositions for  
tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent  
to as certain and fix a true and just Composition for all  
tithes arising growing yielding and payable within the  
parish of Knocktopher in the County of Kilkenny, do hereby  
Certify that the true and just amount of Compositions  
for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is one  
hundred and seventy five pounds by the year  
which sum is due and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Hans  
Hamilton as rector of said Parish as a composition  
for all tithes claimed by him within said Parish

Thereby further Certify that the average price  
of wheat the principal Corn grown in such County for  
the period of seven years ending first day of Nov<sup>r</sup>  
1830. is one pound twelve shillings & one half penny  
per barrel Dated this 7<sup>th</sup> January 1831
