for tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix  
a true and just Composition for all tithes arising growing  
yielded or payable within the Parish of Laccagh in the Diocese  
of Tuam and County of Galway, do hereby Certify that the  
true and just amount of Composition for all tithes whatsover  
within said Parish is two hundred and twenty two pounds  
five Shillings and six pence by the year. One half of which  
is due and payable to the Rev. Peter Barlow as a composition  
for the tithes claimable by him as Vicar of said Parish, and  
one the half is due and payable to the Reverend Geo. William  
Bunford as a composition for the tithes claimable by him  
as Rector of said Parish, and We do further  
Certify that the average Price of Wheat being the Corn  
principally grown in such County for the Period of seven  
years ending on the first day of November 1824  
according to the Dublin average is that eight  
Shillings <sup>eight pence</sup> per barrel
