answer to the communication of his Grace the Duke of
Leinster relative to the Election of a Commissioner.

Dublin Decr 24. 1823

It is notified that the Archbishop of Dublin has
received a paper signed "Leinster Chairman" in
which "It is notified that at a Special Vestry held under
& by virtue of the 4 Geo 4 Chap. 99. for the Parish of
Larabryan in the Diocese of Dublin & County of Kildare
Henry Hamilton Esq^r of Ballymacoll in the County of
Meath was elected by the said Vestry to be a commis-
-sioner under the said Act to fix & ascertain jointly
with a Commissioner to be appointed on behalf of
the Tithe owners of said Parish a composition for
all the Tithes of said Parish pursuant to the
Statute
