

We Henry Mitchell and Alexander Fleming Commissioners duly appointed and Sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth entitled an act to provide for the establishing a Composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising growing Yilded or payable within the parish of Monaghan in the County of Monaghan do hereby certify that a special vestry held in the parish Church of Monaghan on the 9th day of February 1825 under the Lord Lieutenants Warrant for holding the same. That the Rev. Robert Montgomery Rector of said parish having offered to said vestry to take the sum of Six Hundred pounds per annum in lieu of all tithes due or payable out of same and having procured The Lord Bishop of Clogher as sent to the same. And that the said vestry duly assembled unanimously agreed to the same and that the said sum of Six Hundred pounds per Annum be paid to the said Reverend Robert Montgomery or his successors for the space of twenty one years from the 1st day of May 1825 by two half Yearly payments on every ^{November and first day of} ~~May~~ in every year during said period in lieu of all tithes arising growing Yilded or payable out of said parish and that such composition shall be invariable for the space of twenty one years and shall not be subject to any variation in the amount thereof whatever the price of corn may be
