 Composition for all Tithes arising Growing yielded or
 payable within the Parish of Moon and its dependencies
 in the County of Wicklow and Kings County

We hereby certify that the true and
 just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the
 said Parish is Three Hundred and Seventy Eight pounds
 by the Year of which sum of Three Hundred and Seventy
 Eight pounds One third part is due and payable to
 The Rev^d Satham Coddington, as a composition for the Tithes
 claimable by him as Incumbent of said Parish,
 and two third parts is due and payable to the Chapter of
 St. Patrick Dublin as Owners of said two thirds.

And we do further certify that the
 average price of Wheat being the corn principally grown
 in said Counties for the period of seven years ending on the
 first Day of November One thousand Eight Hundred and
 Twenty one is One pound fifteen Shillings and Eight
 pence Half penny of the Barre.
